FAITH COMMUNITY NURSE BASIC PREPARATION COURSE

Overview

This **new class, released in summer 2009**, was developed through the International Parish Nurse Resource Center in St. Louis, Missouri. The curriculum is based on the 2005 ANA recognized specialty of faith community nursing/FCN (also called parish nursing).

Those who are not RNs, but have an interest in the values of FCN, can attend this training to become a Health Minister. RNs that do not have a faith community will learn how to develop their nursing practice to include care of a client's spiritual needs in any setting.

Two-weekend format--first weekend Friday evening, Saturday and Sunday
--second weekend Saturday and Sunday

Includes a dedication ceremony at the end of the course the second Sunday

Cost

Includes 32-hour course, all course materials and final dedication ceremony

Cost is \$100 per person. (Suggested that prospective FCN/HM pay \$50 and sponsoring faith community pays \$50. For each additional student from the same faith community, total cost is \$50 per person.)
